Solicitation Guidance

A few reminders to take with you as you learn about upcoming business opportunities:

- Solicitation Documents: <u>Read with care.</u> These outline specific requirements for content and timing of submissions. Reading with care will also help you to determine whether you are able to provide the services needed.
- Pre-Bid and Proposal Conferences: Don't overlook how valuable these sessions can be. This is your
 opportunity to ask clarifying questions and follow-up in real time. <u>Note that attendance at a Pre-Bid or
 Pre-Proposal Conference is sometimes mandatory.</u>
- Question and Answer Period: In Periscope you may submit questions regarding the solicitation and read answers provided by the County. The duration of the Q&A period is typically included in the schedule within the solicitation.
